For these individuals, finding resources and support is vital to making a difference in their lives. On **Friday, September 30, 2022** the 20<sup>th</sup> Annual Bexar County Behavioral Health and Wellness Conference will connect people to meaningful information about mental illness, substance use disorders, general health and wellness, and local resources.

Located at the Norris Conference Center (618 NW Loop 410), this **FREE** conference presented by The Center for Health Care Services, features a series of informative workshops for people living with a mental health condition and/or substance use disorder, as well as CEU opportunities for professionals, and a community resource fair.

The 20<sup>th</sup> annual event will feature keynote luncheon speaker **Roy Juarez Jr.**, founder of IMPACTtruth, Inc. and author of *Homeless by Choice: A Memoir of Love, Hate, and Forgiveness*. His story began here, on the south side of San Antonio, where he faced dangerous situations and obstacles living in the streets. Regardless of circumstances, it's never too late for that moment of change, and we are hopeful Roy's story will encourage and inspire others in the Bexar County community to do just that.

#### Outline of the 2022 Behavioral Health and Wellness Conference

This free, one-day conference for Bexar County families, consumers, and caregivers offers five workshop tracks and a health and wellness resource fair. The 2019 conference had over 500 participants. This year, we anticipate 600 attendees. Below are descriptions of the five categories of workshops, health and wellness resource fair, and luncheon. The Keynote Speaker and Awards Ceremony luncheon is available for all conference attendees and sponsors.

**Wellness Topics**: This track offers wellness topics for challenges with mental health and substance use disorders. Topics may include, but are not limited to: suicide prevention, trauma healing, healing in the midst of the pandemic and making connections that bring change.

**Mental Health Knowledge:** These workshop sessions offer attendees an opportunity to learn more about topics that are affecting them or a loved one struggling with mental health. Topics may include, but are not limited to: mental health and faith, supported employment options and mental health, testimonials from people with lived experience, and mental health discussions for veterans, peers and everyday life.

**Substance Use Knowledge:** These workshop sessions are for people who are currently seeking services or interested in learning more about substance use challenges. Topics may include, but are not limited to: opioid prevention intervention, addiction and mental health, after treatment/community-based care, co-occurring mental health and addiction, and opiate/benzo alternatives.

**Community Resources Information:** These workshop sessions are geared for people interested in learning more about mental health and substance use resources available in Bexar County including: services for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD), psychiatric advance directives, permanent, affordable housing, the connection between law enforcement and mental health, and legal aid resources.

**Essentials for Caregivers:** These workshop sessions offer caregivers and family members an opportunity to learn how to be a supportive person in a loved one's struggle with mental health and/or substance use challenges while also taking care of themselves. Topics may include, but are not limited to: mental wellness and preventative techniques, how mental health impacts marriage, stress and mental health, and finding focus and balance.

**Professional Development Topics**: These workshop sessions are for mental health and counseling professionals seeking Continuing Education credit to maintain certification and meet licensure renewal requirements. Topics may include, but are not limited to: LGBTQ+ Ally Training, Perinatal Mental Health and Finding Focus and Balance.

Health and Wellness Resource Fair: This fair is open to all conference attendees seeking information on local resources surrounding mental health and/or substance use. Over 30 local agencies are available to provide information on referral services.

**Keynote Speaker and Awards Luncheon**: Our 2022 keynote address will be presented by author, entrepreneur, and activist Roy Juarez Jr. Author of "Homeless by Choice: A Memoir of Love, Hate, and Forgiveness," and founder of the human development company IMPACTtruth, Inc., Juarez built his company with a dream to inspire youth and reunite families by sharing his turbulent yet inspirational life story. Juarez has partnered with national organizations such as the U.S. ARMY, Ford Motor Company Fund, and the United States Hispanic Leadership Institute to inspire millions of individuals across 48 states and seven countries. He has garnered national media attention from outlets such as CNN, Chicken Soup for the Soul, and numerous local and online publications.

Juarez was born on the south side of San Antonio, Texas, where he faced dangerous situations and life-threatening obstacles. At the age of 14, due to domestic violence, Juarez became a high school drop-out and one of the hundreds of homeless youth on the city streets. With only a duffle bag of personal items he called home, Juarez moved from house to house to survive. However, thanks to community members who noticed the invisible student along the way, Juarez graduated from high school in 2000 and earned a bachelor's degree in Business Administration from Hardin-Simmons University in 2009. Regardless of circumstances, it's never too late for that moment of change, and we are hopeful Roy's story will encourage and inspire others in the Bexar County community to do just that.
